Introducing One Stone—a Cabernet Sauvignon offering from the Ancient Peaks family. One Stone is a tribute to all of the women who move mountains, one stone at a time. A portion of each bottle sold is donated to Dream Big Darling, a nonprofit that provides mentorship programs for the next generation of leaders in the wine and spirits industry.

OUR VINEYARDS

The grapes for the 2019 vintage were sourced from our family vineyard and select sites in the Paso Robles AVA on California's Central Coast. Here, diurnal temperature swings, diverse soils and a long growing season all combine to produce rich flavors with structure and elegance. In recent years, Paso Robles has emerged as the next great region for world-class Cabernet Sauvignon, illustrating how local growing conditions are perfect for this preeminent Bordeaux variety.

GIVING BACK

V. 2019 NOTES

WINEMAKING

After harvesting, the fruit was gently destemmed and cold soaked for a measured extraction of color and flavor. At the conclusion of fermentation, the wine was racked to a combination of French and American oak barrels (10% new oak), where it aged for 16 months prior to blending and bottling. Small lots of Merlot and Petit Verdot were incorporated into the final blend for added dimension. The Merlot contributes a velvety fruit component that rounds out the mid palate, while the Petit Verdot intensifies the color and enhances the wine's structure.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 One Stone Cabernet Sauvignon offers a rich aroma profile of cherry and cassis with varietal hints of tobacco and olive. A deep, supple palate presents layered flavors of plum, black cherry and black currant underpinned by notes of mocha, cedar, cola and vanilla spice. Smooth, sweet tannins unfold into a lusciously rounded finish.

FOOD PAIRING

The rich yet approachable character of the 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon is a fine match for ground beef tacos, barbecued chicken, braised short ribs and lamb chops with rosemary butter.
